

## Jancis Robinson Rates TEIRA 2005 Sonoma County Zinfandel in Her Top 100

One of only six North American wines chosen, including Dominus, Frog's Leap and Ridge

Jancis Robinson, wine writer and critic for the *Financial Times* of London, has named our 2005 Sonoma County Zinfandel to her “100 Reds Worth Celebrating” list. Well-known as one of the world’s foremost wine critics, Jancis writes for publications all over the world and co-authored the *World Atlas of Wine*.

“Every year I try to assemble a collection of wines for *Financial Times* readers that I think should be drinking particularly well for celebrations over the year end. I also try to concentrate on wines that are currently fun to drink, so there are none of the wines I have tasted recently which are more suitable for the cellar than the table. I have also tried to favor wines that should go well with the sort of food traditionally served at this time of year.
